I don’t know about you, but I’m still working on my challenge quilt!!!!
However, I know you are all wondering ‘I’m done with my challenge quilt. *Now what do I do?*

1. You can bring it to the February meeting and turn it in, along with your form.
2. You can contact Susan Binzel (I live in the county, 262 857 7725) or Connie DeGraff (She lives on Russell Road, a little east of Hwy 31 847 471-5756) between now and Feb 26 and arrange to turn it over.
3. You can bring the quilt to the museum on quilt turn in day (which is Tuesday Feb 27th). If you do this, please please please fill out the electronic form. In order to do that, go to the web site and click on Programs and then click on museum quilt show registration. When you are done filling everything out, there is a green arrow that says ‘print’. Print the form (and bring it with your quilt). Also, click the Submit button. If you don’t fill it out electronically, it leaves a very short window for one or two of your quilt guild friends to type it all in (and hope we don’t make a mistake), and then get those cute forms printed and laminated.
4. Make sure that your quilt has a label. If you don’t want to do a traditional label, writing your name, the year (2018) and the name of your quilt with pen on the back is acceptable.
