Positively Programs

July 7th, 2025 - Lecture: Margaret Fisher - Quilt Show Judging: Making Your Entry the Best It Can Be

Margaret Fisher was last year's judge for our annual quilt show. Entering your artistic handiwork in a show or competition is a positive learning experience. Margaret will present information that will help you make a great entry and reveal what today's progressive judging of quilts and fiber arts entails. Everyone will benefit from understanding what judges find important in the process of recognizing excellence.

September 8th, 2025 - Catherine Redford - Lecture: Trip Around the World in Folk Art Stitches

Buckle up for a fun lecture with Catherine as she takes you on a humorous, educational, and interactive adventure! Learn more about Catherine and her quilting techniques as you play a game with prizes. Catherine will take you on a trip around the globe with her quilts. Discover how she found her inspiration, the stitches she used, and the finishing techniques she employed in her quilts. Go home ready to embark on your own creative journey!

Tuesday September 9, 2025 All Day Class: Introduction to Folk Art Embroidery (\$55 includes kit)

Start by learning or being reminded of some basic embroidery stitches on a specially designed pre-printed sampler. Then learn some novel embellishment techniques that add to the fun. Learn how Catherine transfers her own designs onto dark-colored backgrounds. Leave the class with a second design transferred and ready to stitch. Enjoy the relaxed tempo and reconnect with handwork. Kit includes printed sampler, hand dyed embroidery threads, needles, embellishments, transfer materials and full color stitch guide. Please bring small scissors. Thimble and small portable light optional. Please note the price has been reduced; SQG is subsidizing the cost of this workshop to make it more affordable.

October 6th, 2025 AQS Certified Quilt Appraiser Allison Rainboth - Quilt Appraisals: What Goes Into Appraisals?

Allison Rainboth will be taking the place of our original speaker, Cathy Glover, due to health reasons.

Allison Rainboth will be sharing her expertise in quilt appraising. Allison is an AQS Certified Appraiser of Quilts and Quilted Textiles, a member of the AQS Appraiser Certification Committee, and an NACQJ Certified Quilt Judge. Her expertise spans both the art and history of quilting, making her a sought-after resource for quilters and quilt collectors alike. We are working with Allison to determine if we are able to have individual appraisals.

November 10, 2025 – Sue Heinz – You Have a Friend in Elmer

Imagine a world where ever seam you stitch is perfect...every block true to size. Can you also imagine precisely matching stripes, accurately piecing circles (with ease!) and eliminating bias stretch forever? Wanna dream even more? Sue Heinz guarantees you will achieve your wildest piecing dreams when you use this simple technique that requires no pins, clips, or gadgets.

Tuesday November 11, 2025 (Federal Holiday so many of you have the day off!) All Day Class: Caffeinated Quilting (9:30 to approx. 4:00) Cost \$35

Sue has brewed up energy-infused designs that will look stunning on your next quilt. Based on her latest book, this class will leave you filled to the brim with new grid, block, and linear designs that are easy to master, especially with Sue's one-on-one teaching style. Come play – leave caffeinated! (No machines needed. Cost includes class fee.)
