We think there will be moveable walls that can take pins for smaller quilts. So, please start thinking about what you want to display. There will be more information next month.





Thanks to everyone who helped support our substitute craft fair initiatives! With the canceling of our standard fundraising events, the opportunity to try something totally different after being cooped up was very appealing. What started out as an opportunity to sell raffle quilt tickets, quickly evolved into a full blown sale. Our first event on June 27th was held at the home of Jessica DeBoer and proved not only fun, but also profitable. We were fortunate the rain clouds passed over without a drop and almost every shopper made a point to tell us that they just wanted to get out, but still wanted to be safe. Our total sales for the day were \$421 of which \$115 was tickets sales. We learned a lot from this sale – and before the day was done we were already strategizing the next one.

We expanded the sale to Peg Malmberg's house, invited a few more vendors to participate and included Carol Potter's items to sell as well. This 2nd sale took place on Saturday, September 26th. We couldn't have asked for a nicer fall day and once again we were amazed with the number of people that came out to support us. Our total sales for the day were \$1,078.00. \$166 of this was for raffle tickets.

Thank you to all the members who donated new inventory items, helped with set up and take down and who worked the sale. We also want to thank the many members who came out and shopped not only at the guild booth, but the other vendors and Carol's sale as well. It was great getting to see so many of you – even if we couldn't hug on each other and had to guess who each other were behind our masks!

We've had many challenges thrown at us with this pandemic and getting to do something as simple as shop at an outside sale helped make life seem more normal, even for just a little bit.
